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## Wound Care Program

Our Wound Care program is intended primarily for patients with open wounds or high-risk feet.

At each Wound Care visit, patients will be seen by an Internal Medicine specialist physician and a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) with specialty training in foot care, wound care, and orthopedics.

When necessary, we will also arrange and coordinate referrals with specialists, including:

- Vascular Surgery
- Plastic Surgery
- Orthopedic Surgery
- Interventional Radiology
- Infectious Diseases
- Surgical Podiatry
- Orthotist
- Physiotherapy
- Internist
- Dietitian
- Diabetes Nurse

Wound Care consultations and follow-up visits are covered by Alberta Health.

Once a patient's wound has healed, we encourage them to continue with our preventative Foot Care program.

## Preventative Foot Care Program

At each Preventative Foot Care visit, patients will be assessed and treated by a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) with specialty training in foot care, wound care, and orthopedics.

Our Preventative Foot Care program is for patients with a wide range of problems, including:

- Diabetes
- Neuropathy
- Calluses
- Thickened or Fungal Nails
- Chronic Charcot Foot
- Previous Amputation
- Ingrown Toenails
- Venous Insufficiency
- Compression Therapy

Preventative Foot Care is not covered by Alberta Health. These services may be reimbursable, in part or in full, through private insurance.
